Trig Road Upgrade Project

An upgrade is planned for Trig Road to bring it up to urban standard and support transport choice for current and future Whenuapai residents.

The upgrade is for the section of Trig Road south of SH18 through to Hobsonville Road, and will include an upgrade of the intersections of Trig and Luckens Roads with Hobsonville Road. The upgrade would also provide for walking, cycling, public transport and general traffic.

Where are we now?

Work to date

Two potential alignments have been assessed for an upgrade to the southern section of Trig Road:

- Using the existing road
- Realigning the road into the greenfield land to the east to connect with Luckens Road

An upgrade of the existing Trig Road was chosen.

Next steps

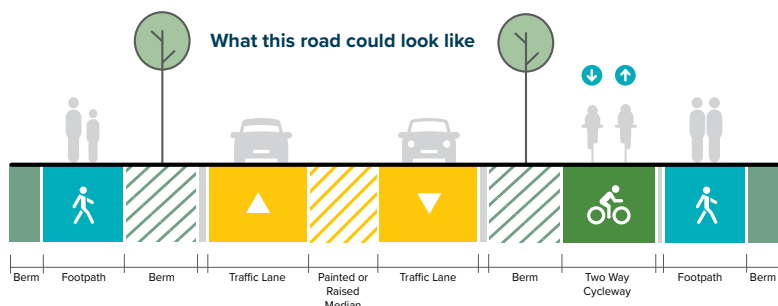
This project is progressing with further technical work and engagement with potentially affected property owners.

The applications for route protection and resource consent for the Trig Road Upgrade Project are intended to be lodged in 2020.

The construction of the Trig Road Upgrade Project is likely to occur in the next few years. It is funded by the Government's Housing Infrastructure Fund, which helps to bring forward the development of transport infrastructure to support growth and housing development in high growth urban centres.
